Science - Animals including humans

*Identify that animals, including humans, need the right types and amount of nutrition, and that they cannot make their own food; they get nutrition from what they eat.

Identify that humans and some other animals have skeletons and muscles for support, protection and movement.

History- Ancient Egypt Location, origin in settlements around the Nile, living by the Nile Ancient Egyptian religion, government, art, great monuments, beliefs about death, farming.

Geography-Rivers The River Indus - its source, course, uses (ancient & modern) and some of its environmental challenges.

How rivers get their water - the source, springs, the water cycle. Flooding.

Music - Ocarina

*Learn the basics of playing the ocarina: *Holding correctly, notes, reading simple music and playing together

PSHE Belonging and Beginning

- *To establish class rules thinking about what helps us learn
- *Think about how we build relationships in the class.
- *Discuss how we feel in a new situation

English - Writing - Recount letters. All our work will be based around



- *Write a program in Scratch to create the animation, including characters, dialogue, costumes, backdrops and sound
- *Review their animation programs and correct mistakes.
