Dear Parent/Carer

The Making of Harry Potter tour – Year 4 trip, Wednesday 9th October

As part of our learning and 'Potions' topic, we would like to take the children, on Wednesday 9th October, to Warner Bros. Studio Tour London to complete the Harry Potter experience and tour. This is an exciting opportunity which will enhance the children's learning and create engagement and enjoyment of the text being studied during the Autumn Term.

We will be travelling by coach, leaving school at 8.30am and returning to school at approximately 4.15pm depending on traffic. Please could we therefore ask that **your child arrives at school 8.15am** to enable us to leave on time. As the school playground will not be accessible at this time, your child should enter school via school reception on this day. We appreciate your cooperation with this.

Your child should wear school uniform and bring a packed lunch and drink (no fizzy drinks please). They will not need to bring any money with them.

Normally, this visit would not be viable due to the costs involved for transport and admission. However, we are very fortunate to have received a donation from FONS which will lessen the cost to parent/carers. We would therefore like to request a contribution of £29.80 per child to enable the trip to go ahead.

External visits which enhance the curriculum are an 'extra' which, in our experience, all children benefit from. We receive no additional funding for this and so the visit can only go ahead if parent/carers are willing to make a contribution to cover the costs. If we do not receive sufficient contributions to cover the cost of the trip it may not be possible for it to go ahead. If you are experiencing difficulty in meeting the cost of this trip please book an appointment, in confidence, to see Mrs Marrs.

Please complete and return the form attached **no later than Thursday 12th September** at which time we will make a decision as to whether the trip can proceed.
